### **FEE**

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION**

The participants should be graduate in science / engineering / technology and should have minimum 2-3 years experience in the field of packaging. The participants could be middle level executives engaged in production/process, quality control, purchase, marketing activities, product-package R & D activities.

### **LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY**

Since the programme will be conducted in English, the participants are expected to be proficient in English language.

### **SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS**

Each WPO member will select the candidates in their respective country based on qualification and experience and forward a list of 5 candidates in order of priority, to WPO Secretariat. Depending upon the response received from each country, the WPO Secretariat will shortlist the candidates equally from each country with restriction of maximum 20 participants.

The selection of participants will be intimated by APF by 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2010.

The APF/IIP will issue certificates to the participants on successful completion of the programme. Best country paper presentation/project work will be awarded.
