The official Launch cum Press meet for INDIAPACK 2010 organized by the Indian Institute of Packaging (IIP) on Monday, 11th January 2010 at Hotel The Leela Kempinski, Mumbai. This Industry meet was held on the occasion of IIPs' most awaited mega packaging exhibition INDIAPACK 2010 to be held during Sept 30th – 3rd October 2010 at Bombay Exhibition Centre, Mumbai. The packaging industry stalwarts and the leading press witnessed the most professionally organized Launch cum Press meet for the leading Packaging exhibition in India.
